



SUTCLIFFE VINEYARDS

Elevation: 5340 FT (1628m)

Across the moonlike landscape that is much of the Navajo reservation, it is difficult to anticipate the slender beautiful oasis of McElmo Canyon. Suddenly you are on Battlerock Ranch, the home of Sutcliffe Vineyards, which lies beneath the towering monolith from which it draws its name. Seven acres are planted to vines: Merlot, Chardonnay, Cabernet Franc and Syrah. This is the very definition of a boutique vineyard and the wines have limited availability. Coming from the west you will already have passed the twenty acres of the Canyon of the Ancients Vineyard where further of their grapes are grown. Open Daily, Sutcliffe Vineyards is able to ship wines not only to every state in the Union (laws permitting) but also to several countries abroad.
