Lake Farmington covers 215 acres and is managed by the City of Farmington. It is popular for family friendly outdoor adventures and is open year-round for fishing and seasonally to electric and non-motorized watercraft.

Boating, fishing, swimming, mountain biking, horseback riding, and wildlife watching.

Lake access fees are required for park entrance and daily boating fee.

Fishing

Fishing is permitted year round. Lake species include rainbow trout, largemouth bass, catfish and even pike. A valid New Mexico Game and Fish fishing licenses required.
