No overnight camping is permitted, but day use of pavilions with picnic tables and BBQ grills are available. Restrooms are ADA compliant and a 1/2 mile walking trail around the lake is available.

Fees

No lake use fees required.
A valid New Mexico Game and Fishing license is required.
Reservations can be made for special use of the pavilions (505) 334-7670.

Fishing

Fishing is permitted year round with a valid New Mexico Game and Fishing license. The lake is stocked regularly with rainbow trout. Channel catfish is also present.
